QUETZAL TRINCADEIRA DA COROA 2023

REGION: Alentejo.

DESIGNATION: D.O.C. Alentejo -Vidigueira.

VARIETIES: 100% Trincadeira.

SOIL : Pronounced sloping schistous soils with medium yield potencial.

CLIMATE: In the heart of Vidigueira lies Quetzal's unique terroir, set on steep schist soils. The hot Alentejo days are tempered by cool Atlantic breezes, held back by the Serra do Mendro, creating a temperature range that is truly unique in Alentejo.

VINIFICATION: Sheltered underground, our ageing cellars allow us, to work preserved from the heat, at our own times, in the calm of the Alentejo land, respecting its times and values. The 12 months of aging in period in used 500L barrels ensures total respect for the raw material, enhancing the wine's development and fullest expression.

TASTING NOTES: With a pale salmon color, aroma of fresh fruit, where watermelon and notes of dried prairie, offer layers of delicate complexity. Tense and dry, the mouth with light and salivating tannins, have a finish balanced, refreshed by crunchy acidity.

PAIRING SUGGESTION : Quetzal Trincadeira is a rosé wine with a distinctly gastronomic character, pairing beautifully with grilled fish, beef carpaccio, mild cheeses, cherry-glazed chicken, shrimp açorda, and sushi. In its aromas, flavours, textures, and colours, we present a new expression of our nature, the new Rosé de Trincadeira da Coroa.
